Empowering Gambian Farmers Through Quality Seeds

Agricultural Background

Gambian horticultural farmers face major challenges in crop production. Access to quality seeds is one of the most critical. The seeds of most vegetables grown in the country are imported, and due to macroeconomic instability, costs continue to rise with currency depreciation and inflation. As a result, seeds are becoming increasingly unaffordable, worsening the livelihoods of many farming households. Even when seeds are available locally, quality is often poor with low germination rates.

Vegetable Seeds and Funding

We are delighted to report that Seeds for Prosperity received outstanding support from generous donors around the world. Below is a summary of funding received this season.

Seeds Distribution

A total of 218 kg of seeds were distributed between November 2025 and January 2026. The quantities below reflect farmer demand, with onion being the most sought-after crop — virtually none of the farmers can produce their own onion seeds.

Farmers Reached

This season we reached 97 village gardens serving a total of 107 settlements across The Gambia. With an average of approximately 260 farmers per garden, we estimate that around 25,000 farmers benefited from our seed distribution program — representing a significant year-on-year growth.
